Rules and Regulations-GENERAL

Each approved member will be issued with a copy of these rules and regulations and Permit, which is not transferable

Each approved member will supply an up-to-date personal photograph

The Permit is to be carried at all times when in Association fishing areas

Any misuse of the Privilege Ticket will render a member liable to disqualification

A member must present his/her Permit when required by a RoDMA Waterman, Ranger or Bailiff.

Failure to do so will result in him/her leaving the fishing area

Members must not take any non-fishing guest onto secure areas other than those identified on the Permit

Any infringement by a member's guest will result in cancellation of membership

Fishing is only permitted in clearly identified/designated areas

Members found fishing outside a designated area will immediately forfeit the Permit

No parking facilities are provided by the association. Vehicles are not permitted on the quayside

Parking in the vicinity of the Royals must take into account of the local community

Any action by a member that brings the Association into disrepute will result in cancellation of membership

Access to fishing area fronting ExCEL Exhibition Centre may be restricted or removed during shows

ANGLING

Only one rod is to be used at any one time

Braid as hook length is not to be used

Barbless hooks (maximum size 10) are only to be used

Keep nets are not to be used

Night fishing is not permitted

No member shall play or permit to be played any radio or musical instrument

Members must remove all ground bait, litter, metal cans and tins

THE FIRST TWO FISH CAUGHT CAN BE KEPT. ALL SUBSEQUENT fish are to be returned to the water live and unharmed

No fishing from Marina premises

ALWAYS RETURN THE FISH WHATEVER THE SPECIES TO THE WATER AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE.

MINIMUM HANDLING EQUALS MAXIMUM CONSERVATION
